Utility Meeting

Heard report of Morris Vaughn reported 7 ½ % H2O loss mostly due to 4 leaks.
Talked about H2O line extension on Keller rd.
Paperwork was lost by the Division of H2O but still working on it.

Robbie reported that the Jacksonville water tank will be painted tomorrow.
It was decided to put up a plaque in the honor of Butch Watson for the Jacksonville project.

Talked about H2O crossing at US 27 & KY 635.
Donnie had letter from Darcy Stewart concerning a 4in line. He "feel's it needs a 6in" line.
