Visitor Donna & Ed Young were present. They were asking to be reimbursed for the \$400.00 they paid for H2O hook-on fee. Other things talked about - pump station on part of their property etc. This was tabled until next meeting, will check on the above.

It was mentioned that the croquet lot was looking good and still being worked on.

Heard report from Morris Vaughn; reported 8.2% H2O loss had several leaks mainly due to bad water pipes, too low PSI; all been replaced by better ones.

Talked about H2O & H2O pressure on Stringtown Rd. Tank was out of H2O but Robbie and Morris will fix using another pump. Will be fixed by Thursday.

The electric line to the Jacksonville H2O tank will cost much less than first reported. Cost now should be \$2500.00 rather than \$5000.00.

The meeting with Darrell Wilson and Darrell Beshears was discussed on trying to get \$50,000.00 for the sewer project. They will get back with the City on this as there was no comment at the present time.

Talked about infiltration at different locations, will keep checking on this during heavy rains.

Dallas reported 98.1 bod and 94.7 solids removed also Nitrogen of 96.4% he reported that we had received 2.3in of rain.

Wagon Wheel had reimbursed \$1500.00 in tap-on fees.
