Mike Gooch reported Jacksonville fire station was built. Talked whether to meter water to it or not. May put a blow-out at station. Donnie will work with Tiger Robinson on the above and was given permission by Council to make decision on this.

It was reported that there was contingency money left from the H2O project. City decided to take bids on a backhoe for the City.
