Meeting opened with prayer by Jr. Dick.

Mayor Bill Dick and David Phelps were not present at meeting.

Jr. Dick was in charge of the meeting. Had Visitor Jamey Tilley from Cumb. Sed. Bank gave a short talk on her work at the bank.

Utility Meeting

Water report was given by Robbie Gossett reported 4.6% H₂O loss, Copy of monthly operating Report was handed out. There were several major water leaks during this time – had 4 or more in Twin Lakes Subdivision, one in Camelot and a bad one in Melrose place, had more than a million gallons of water loss, maybe up to 2-3 million.

Customer Confidence Report (CCR's) go out this month.

Sewer report was given by Robbie Gossett. He reported BOD 99.2%. Solids 98.4% and N at 97.5%.

Had zero exceptions for April. Sewer repairs for June – Pump at Main plant failed for 2 ½ weeks, had to be operated by a borrowed one from Southern States. Paul Vaught will begin Construction on building to house new Control Station for Sewer plant, as the new Pumps are due the 3rd week of this month and the new panel due the last of this month.

Talked about Construction of additional building next to the Control building and one main pit for Pulling pumps and removing trash from influent at lift Station.

Motion was made by Mike Hall that Paul Vaught Construct the above building talked about, seconded by Terry Wesley.

Motion was made by Terry Wesley to pay Utility bills, seconded by Mike Hall.

For new Business change order 2 & 3 has been started which will bring Sewer service to customers on the East side of Frog Hollow road and along Hwy. 27.

Had Visitors from Perry St. Devel. With a complaint about their Neighbor having trash and other items outside their homes.
