Heard H2O report by Robbie, reported 3.1% loss, monthly operating report was handed out, had water repairs on Norwood Rd, main station pumps went down for 2 days, water leak in Camelot Sub, and repaired two lawns in Twin Lakes that been torn up.

Robbie also gave sewer report, had Bod 99.1%, solids 98.7% on N 97.5. Had 2 exceptions for July – one on fecal, one on chlorine. Had sewer repairs On main pump and also pumps at Don Robinson and Bobby Dick's. When new panel arrives, the new pumps will be put into service, probably next week.

Mayor reported the last sewer construction meeting for the current project will be completed next Tuesday, and hopefully will close it all out.
