Minutes of Commission Meeting March 3, 2009

Meeting opened with silent prayer.
Minutes of previous meeting were read, motion by David Phelps to accept seconded by Terry Wesley.
Motion carried.

Financial report was presented in the form of a hand out.

Motion was made by David Phelps to accept and also pay regular monthly bills, seconded by Mike Hall. Motion carried.

Robbie Gossett gave water report, reported 1.9% water loss and a copy of the monthly operating report was handed out. Water repairs for Feb. Telemetry still malfunctioning, Mickey Artery has been called to check it the next time he is in the county.

Had several meters to freeze and bust during the cold spell most was because the lids were off some. New meters were installed for the ones that froze and burst.

Robbie Gossett gave Sewer report, reported 98.7% bod, 98.5% solids and N at 97%. Had 3 exceptions for Feb. two on fecal and one on flow. Repaired sewer pump at Jeff Leighs, had to have new rails put in, said rails break lots of time when pump is pulled.

Also two pumps at Hardees' had to be rebuilt. The alarm at the Frog Hollow station went off 3 times, this was due mainly to high flow.

Talked about the grease trap at Hardees' City may start pumping it themselves and charging them for it.

Mike Gooch gave Fire Dept. report, reported his runs, and meetings they had preformed. Report was in the form of a handout. Had 13 runs in Feb. making 22 for the year.

Heard Police report by Robbie Gossett, reported all activities he had preformed also had hand out. He reported that Kenny Shepherd was

gone on active duty and length of stay not known yet.

Other items talked about.

1. Two stimulus packages were turned in to congressman Rogers' office for one generator for sewer plant and main water pump station also one for overpass crossing Norfolk Southern Railroad.
2. Turned in three grant applications to KIA sewer extension phase 2 for sewer plant upgrades and replacements water line upgrades from Somerset to Science Hill. City feels they ought to get some money for these.

Will have second reading of Ord 02/17/09 next meeting on 03/17/09.

Will try and get some inmates to clean up park, may get some women to help also. Talked about removing old crossties off bank cross from Macs Village Pantry, had some complaints and also they are beginning to rot.

City had put in for a 10,000 Grant from Kingsford, did receive 4900.00 will get probably first of April. Submitting recyclable grant for recycling trailer with county, trying to get 2-3 of them.

Talked about Spring Clean up charge for last one was 600.00 dumping fee may do in April.

Mayor Bill Dick had letter from Donnie Phelps asking permission to have prayer group meetings every Thursday night at City Hall Bld.

City Council feels like this is not a good idea, they think one of The churches would let them. David Phelps approved having Mayor send Back to Donnie Phelps on the above.

Motion was made by Bill Dick to have Mike Hall's name put on letter for Checks. Seconded by Jeff Wesley.

Motion carried.

Mike Gooch, Fire Chief told council he was trying to get City of Science Hill's rating dropped one point that is from class 6 to class 5. ISO rating.

Motion was made by Terry Wesley to adjourn. Seconded by David Phelps. Motion was carried.
